Yeah, you read right; I got into a company! It's this cute little one called Petal Entertainment, and everyone I met on staff seems super nice. I honestly didn't expect this like?? I played the GUITAR like a FOOL Everyone else was dancing and singing and rapping and a combination of two and I played the BASS GUITAR like some weird emo kid TT

But, apparently, the CEO liked it—liked me! He liked me enough to onboard me and I'm heading back to Seoul this weekend. I don't even know what to expect, but let's see what happens!

But I'm also so so excited! This is such a big opportunity for me and I hope I don't choke or screw it up somehow.

I tried doing some composing on my violin (Yep, I got back into that) and then piano, then guitar, but I couldn't focus because of how bad I felt. My mind just kept drifting back to the encounters and replaying them word for word like some broken record. It was one a.m. when I finally gave up, but I couldn't sleep.

I didn't want to call Shiwoo because I know he doesn't sleep nearly enough and I didn't want to wake him on the off chance that he actually was sleeping. I didn't want to call Dong or Seungdong either... cause I'm their rock. How can I be a rock for them if I'm sobbing into the receiving end of my phone to them in the middle of the night? I ended up calling Hangyu-oppa at around 1.30ish. I was so relieved when he picked up that I actually started crying.

And my kind, selfless, overbearing oppa instantly started panicking and I could hear him shuffling around like he was putting on clothes and getting ready to come get me.

Iksan is over an hour away from Seoul.

I had to force myself to calm down so I could actually speak and explain everything. To explain that I wasn't in immediate harm and that he didn't have to come out of his way. We started off talking about how I felt, but eventually, it just became a nice catch-up. We had a really long conversation. 2

hours and some change. It made me feel a little better about things, but...I don't know... I've got to try harder to keep people happy and beat back the feelings telling me to just go home. I'll do my best.

Shiwoo and I missed our 6 monthiversary like FOOLS so we made up for it with what I like to call The Great Late Date! (both in time elapsed and time of day lol). First, we went to a video game bar and even though he totally obliterated me at Mario, I had the most fun I've had in a while. The food was really good too and the European guys running the place were nice and had interesting stories to tell, so I'll definitely be going back. Maybe it'll be my new haunt hehe

After the bar, we went out to the beach and started a little bonfire for just the two of us. I brought s'mores stuff, so we made s'mores and had as much fun as you can have on a beach at 11 o'clock at night. We got into a sandball fight. Or, well, I threw sand at him first after he splashed me and it went on from there. We got into the last taxi of the night all covered in sand, so we paid the driver extra for the clean up Iol. January 29th, 2020 ((2 years after previous entry))

It's been a really long time, wow.

I got really busy first and then a million things started happening at once and I either couldn't find the time to write or the will to do so. But here I am, trying again. I have a lot to talk about, so sit tight!

First of all, Diamond Divas never debuted. We got so close to D-Day that we released video and image teasers! Teasers!! But then things just stopped suddenly. And Heenim wouldn't even explain why.

After a while, Mimi left without a word and then Mina left because of family troubles. So, we had to restart a bit. The company added a Thai girl named Mint as our new rapper and she's so cute! I adore her and she's easily one of my best friends now. So, with Mintty, we started working to debut again with a new song, a new album entirely. It took a while, but we got to the recording bit and recorded our solos.

Then...things just stopped again. For us and for the ACE boys, who'd also been preparing their album for ages. It seemed like we couldn't catch a break!

Myung is finally doing his service and we miss him a ton, but the Do twins are doing a good job of filling his spot now and then (even though they're not nearly as...him as he is lol.) And with constantly being on my toes around Minha and Mimi. I much prefer being relaxed and loved.

So yeah, I'm really enjoying this simple life that I never imagined myself living! I admit it and I'll scream it to the heavens. Only, it's 3 am right now (I randomly got the urge to open this and write, idk) so, I'll scream it out later.

I honestly don't have much (more) to say now and I'm not sure if I will have anything extra exciting to say tomorrow. Or the day after. Or a few weeks from now. 50, I won't promise to write again soon. I will, however, promise to write again once anything worthwhile happens. 50, I'll see you then 50
